



Meeting held at: Abbeys Pizza, Redmond

- Meeting was brought to order by David Boyd promptly at 7:00 with review of last meetings topics, agenda for this meeting, a reminder for next meeting being held in Bend at Papa's on South end 97. Every 3<sup>rd</sup> month meetings will be in Redmond at Abbeys.
- Officer reports were given.
- Secretary: No report given.
- Novice Coach: Morgan provided updates on High School participation. Alternative autocross event discussed, event was a go and the tech inspection was defined.
- Publicity: Pamela mentioned the 11 X 17 posters were still not printed and Peggy Wodtli is calling to resolve current issue. Updated flyers were provided to club member for distribution. David suggested we go to a single sided flyer as they are difficult to read in windows were backlight is present. Window tinting also adds to the difficulty in reading the information. Pam also brought up if you need help with sponsors or additional packets to contact her, the bottom of the form has the contact numbers.
- Competition Directors: No update at this time. Course design for first event is prepared. Alternative AC event course will be a basic slalom allowing the tail happy motion away from curbs for safety.

- Timing: David discussed the issue with timing equipment has been resolved, bad cord. We now have 200 foot cords to move the timing station further away from the action. Stanchion construction update is needed, these were to allow timers to be outside of the course area.

The requirement for helmets is Snell 90, 95 or 2000 as a minimum, SA rated helmets are legal to use but not required. Let David know now, with size, if you're interested to get on the list. It is possible the minimum 10 order can be different shirts.



- Additional topics tabled by David:

  4. COPS "Shootout might not be the best name, "Stampede" might be more appropriate. This event was still being put together more information to follow.
  5. Special Olympics event being put together where special Olympians would have the opportunity to ride in cars on the track. Coordination for special needs was discussed. Attempting to get a celebrity to come to the event for autographs again more later as details unfold. Underage riders would require consent forms signed by parent or guardian.
  6. Rule books were ordered but not received. There will be seven for sale once received. The link on the web site does not cover all classes. Anyone who has a book should bring to Event #1 in case we do not receive club copies in time.
  7. All Club members were requested to be at the event site early to assist in the setup of the event. Tear down is also another time where more hands make the work go faster.
  8. On time start was stressed as the club grows we need to become more scheduled to keep the events flowing. All workers need to familiar with the jobs assigned and have their areas ready to go when before the event starts.
  9. Camping at the fairgrounds is not free, contact the fairgrounds to arrange overnight accommodations. \$12 dry camping, \$15 with electricity. Super 8 Motel offers 10% discount on event weekends, must mention ACCO event. Walmart will allow free overnights with motorhome.
