

2005 ACCO Meeting Minutes

Feb. 2, 2005

Introductions – everyone introduced themselves and what they drive.

Treasurer Report – David reported that the club has just under \$4000 in the account.

Schedule

- Events – We need someone to step up and get color separations on the logos so we can produce the business cards with schedules on the back. Tim McGinnis volunteered.
- Meetings – Request to move meetings to the first Thursdays due to David having a meeting in Salem on the 1st Wednesday. Members agreed to move to Thursdays. David will make changes on the web and with Pappa's.

Registration Form – What changes should we make to the Orange registration cards that you get at registration and use for Tech. inspection. We will switch Car# and Class into the order the axware takes. Also Last Name/First to First/Last Name. We will add a Run 5 slot under timing. We agreed to put the schedule on the back of the worker tab. We also talked about putting information on the back of registration to cover Driver expectations, Safety check list and worker duties. Following the meeting the publicity crew thought putting on the back of the course maps would give drivers more time to read and they would always have with them through-out the day. We will place on the agenda for March.

Membership Form – No changes were identified for the Membership forms, the ones that registration uses to show on a yearly bases the event, merchandise, and membership status.

1st & 2nd Champions Self Tech – David proposed to allow self tech as other clubs due for the Champions. The club agreed that this was not seen as necessary at this time. Insurance was of concern as well as the little things we check that get over looked by the drivers.

Insurance – David reported that NASA has not sent any information for the new year as of the meeting time. He will contact Peggy Hale to see about insurance for the year. It was asked how much insurance has been. Yearly in around \$200 for X number of active members and \$275/event, a weekend of two events only counts as one insured event.

Van work – The van needs work on the inside on shelves and floor. The heater core needs work so the defroster works. The outside needs paint at some point. Marvin Wodtli volunteered carpeting from Floor Décor. It was also noted that we need to label where things go so David does not have to be there. Things do fit in pretty tight. The van also needs new tires all the way around. David is to set up a date and email local members.

Rule Books – SCCA web site has SOLO II rule books in a PDF format, it has been mentioned that you can not print though (this has not been verified). David will place order for SOLO II and GCR for the club and try to get additional copies to sell to members. Otherwise members can pick them up in Portland at Race Central or Competition Motorsports or order online at SCCA. It is also noted that ACCO closely follows SCCA SOLO II preparation rule and classifications.

Equipment Needs – What equipment would the club like to have? More speakers, another reader board, cones, printer/copier/scanner, another laptop for registration, Wi-Fi for linking the two laptops and printer into axware. Also need to mark the helmets better to help with sharing and identification. Possibly another generator is needed for registration and the PA area.

Officers – We will elect officers at the March meeting. David will place the duties of the officers on the web. The members also would like to identify a way of rewarding the officers for the time they donate to the club to make it work. Further work in this area is needed at the next meeting.

- Publicity Peggy Wodtli, Curtis Hagner, Chris Hibbits and Jack Gassaway volunteered to step up and get things started in Publicity and the Stampede.

- It was also talked about a new position of Safety Steward. This will be added.

- Marvin Wodtli volunteered for Tech Inspection.

- David will continue as President and Treasurer until he is paid in full by the club.

David will present to the club an accounting of amount that was fronted and how much remains.

Lot Layout – Need to move the pedestrians away from the inside grass and sidewalk area. The yellow rope will be extended to enclose the whole lot.

Pre-register Program – Morgan brought up the services offered by outside groups to pre-register for event. He will check into more on cost and compatibility with axware.

Stampede – We need to get started on the COPS asap. The Publicity group will tackle this next week at their meeting. Meeting will be at Lumbermens Insurance on Wednesday at 6:00 pm.

Email – It was noted that if your email has been changed it would be nice if you removed your old one and installed your new one at the web page. David noted that so many email bounced back from the mass email program we are using that it is to time consuming to correct or send out single emails. David will check into the limits of the program about blind emails thus they might get through spam detectors. It was also requested that you install info@autoxclub.org into your address book as this also help from becoming spam.

Cascade Middle School X-games – Morgan talked about and the club agreed to support the schools fund raiser on March 12th. Contact Morgan if you are will to donate fun runs

to be auctioned off and if you can bring your car to the event. ACCO is in support of events like this, we also donated to the Special Olympic a year membership and all events for 2005.
